

Connecting to Eduroam

Windows 10 Instructions



After you work through this initial configuration document, you should automatically connect to eduroam when you are using Concordia's wireless network.

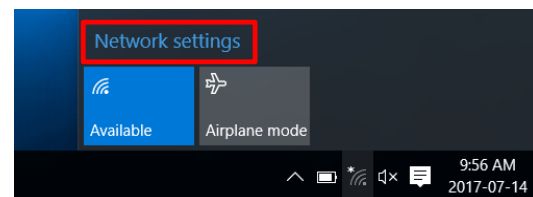
Before you start this procedure, ensure the following:

- Your wireless card and its drivers have been installed and you have rebooted your laptop since the installation.
- You have administrative access to the laptop.
- Your laptop is powered on and booted up.
- You are in an area with wireless coverage.
- Your computer's wireless switch or button is turned on.
- You have a Staff or Student Domain account and password.
- You are using Windows, and not a third-party application, to manage your wireless connections.

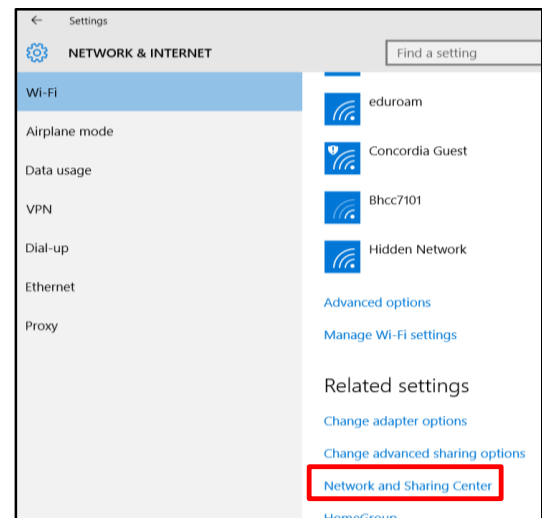
1. Click on the **Wi-Fi icon** near the clock on the taskbar



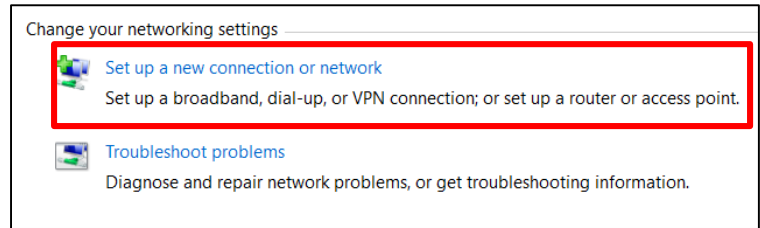
2. Click on **Network Settings**



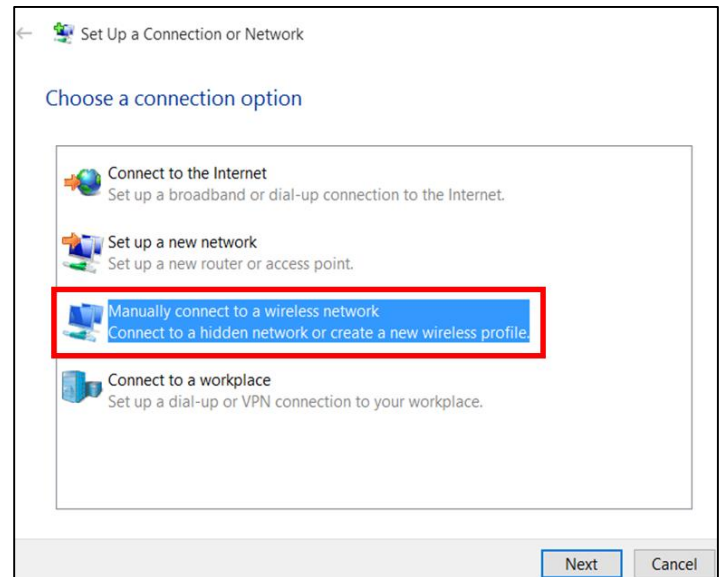
3. Click on **Network and Sharing Centre**



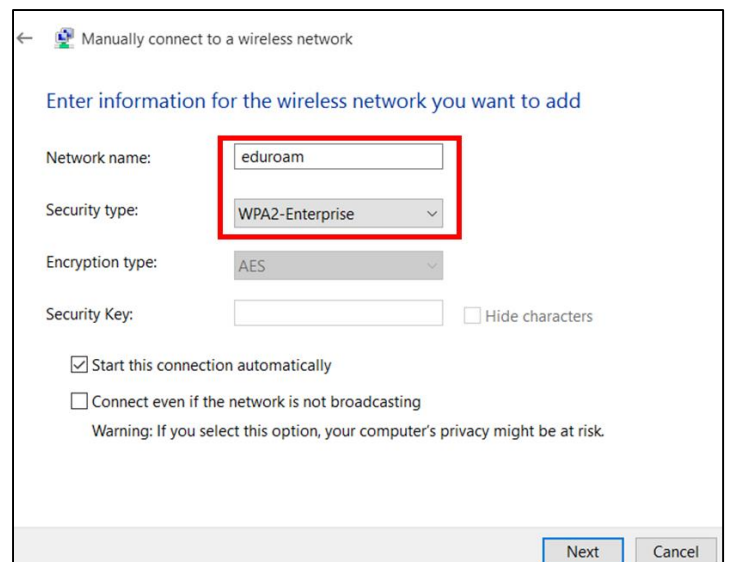
4. Click on **Set up a new connection or network**



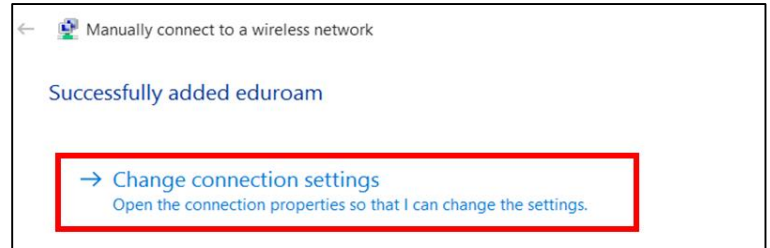
5. Select **Manually connect to a wireless network**;
Click **Next**



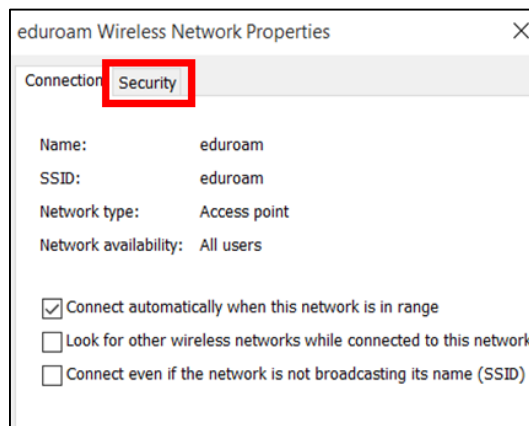
6. Enter the network name **eduroam**;
Change the security type to **WPA2-Enterprise**;
Select **Next**.



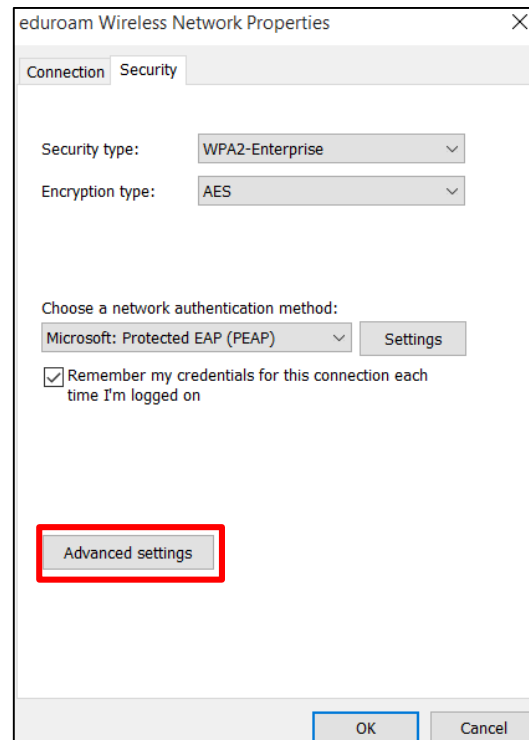
7. Select **Change connection settings**



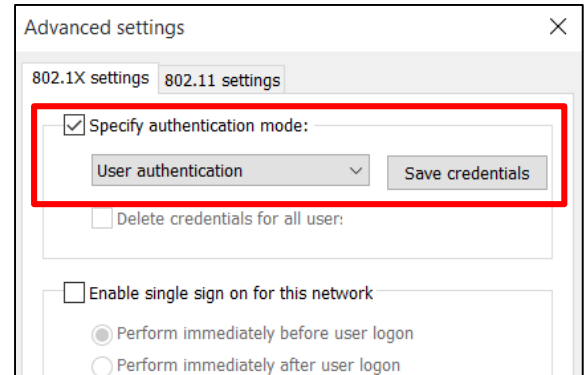
8. Click on the **Security** tab



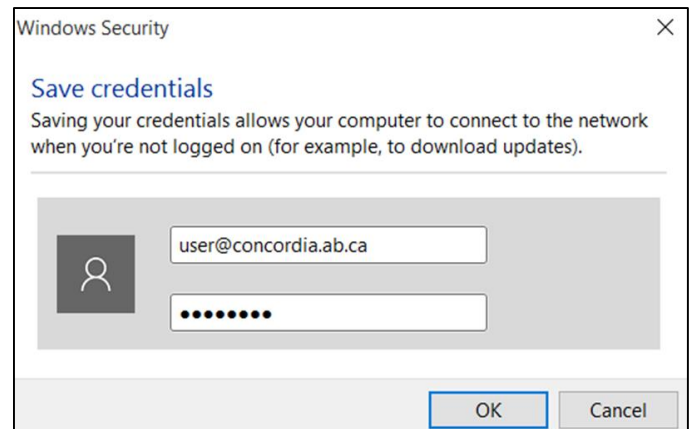
9. Click on **Advanced Settings**



10. Check the box that says **Specify Authentication Mode**;
Change the drop down to **User Authentication**.
Click **Save Credentials**



11. Enter your **Concordia University credentials**;
Click **OK**



12. Click on the **Wi-Fi icon**, select **eduroam**;
Click **Connect**.
